Vineyard

Special Release Shiraz Pinot Noir is a blend of Shiraz (60%) from our Baulkham Vineyard and Pinot Noir (40%) from our 4 & 8 Acres Vineyard. Both are planted on heavy red clay soils over limestone.

Vintage Conditions

2019 was the third strong red vintage in succession in the Hunter Valley, the continued dry conditions from previous years have produced elegant wines with great balance and freshness.

Winemaker's Notes

Both wines were fermented and matured separately, both in older oak of varying sizes. The two wines were blended in December before bottling in January 2019.

Tasting Notes

Floral, bright red fruit flavours with a touch of spice and incredible drinkability, this is a modern interpretation of the great Hunter River Burgundies made famous in the mid-1900s.
